About the workbooks

Each workbook has 10 worksheets that put the children in a role they might come across in real life, and challenge them to complete a series of tasks relating to the landmarks and history of Coventry.

Each worksheet begins with an introduction that explains the story, as well as the role the children will take on to make the activity more engaging. The children must use their maths skills to solve problems they encounter in their role.

When will the children be able to use the worksheets?

These worksheets can be given to children who have completed the work in the subject area for their year group, or as a reminder activity based on what was covered in previous years.

Do they incorporate national curriculum objectives?

Each worksheet incorporates one or more of the objectives set by the national curriculum for the subject area for each year group. The objectives are stated within the teacher instructions.

Format of workbooks

Children's workbook

1. Each workbook contains 10 worksheets, and in some cases an additional presentation to guide the children through the activity. Once you've downloaded the workbook you can either print the entire workbook, or select and print the worksheets you'd like to use.
